The Nelson Diocese is a diocese with Overseas missions at its heart. - we are a sending and receiving Church. An important aspect of being part of The Anglican Church in New Zealand, Aotearoa and Polynesia is our commitment and support to the work of our overseas missions organisation, Anglican Missions through which CMS, receive the bulk of their funding. This is the largest source of funding for NZCMS and also supports specific projects (Lenten appeal, water tanks etc)
