



OBJECTS OF THE TRUST

- 4.1** To provide Assessment, Support, Care, Advocacy, Education, Training. and Welfare Services for Children, Young Persons and their Families/Whanau.
- 4.2** To provide Respite and Support Services that offers sanctuary to Children/Young Persons in need of an alternative home life.
- 4.3** To provide support to Families/Whanau and Caregivers whose Child/Children/Young Persons need time-out in a safe environment.
- 4.4** To provide holistic programmes, that will meet the needs of Children/Young Persons using the Services of the St Andrews Trust.
- 4.5** To advocate for Resources and Services.
- 4.6** To provide 24hr. 7 days a week services that embrace children Young Persons and their Families/Whanau.
- 4.7** To provide appropriate community programmes in partnership with providers who have similar objectives
- 4.8** To formulate Policies and initiate change for the improvement to the quality of life for Children/Young Persons.
- 4.9** To promote the importance of Family/Whanau, through Education, Advocacy and Research.
- 4.10** To eliminate through Education and Advocacy, barriers which limit Families/Whanau ability to cope.
- 4.11** To support Education Programmes that value Children, Young Persons and their Families/Whanau
- 4.12** To develop networks that support and encourage the aims of the Trust.
- 4.13** To ensure that Children, Young Persons and their Families/Whanau Rights are protected.
- 4.14** To ensure that whilst the Trust is committed to Tikanga Rua/BiCultural Development, it also supports People from other Cultures.
